# Pregnancy Care Center

Dear Friends for Life,

You have heard us talk about “change” and “a new direction” for the past few months. But I want to share with you why this was necessary. We face three main challenges: 1) reaching women that are at “high-risk” to have an abortion, 2) reaching women who are actually pregnant, and 3) influencing the majority of those women to choose life. As a post-modern culture continues to change, we realized last year that we were not reaching many abortion-at-risk women who were actually pregnant. And if we didn't have those women coming in our doors, then we weren't seeing many women choose life.

To “erase the need for abortion” one woman at a time is much more than a motto, it is a passion. We have a commitment to do everything we can to serve women facing unplanned pregnancies. So we have made significant changes as to how we operate and serve abortion-at-risk women. Through training, constant evaluation, and a lot of hard work, we have transitioned to using an “Optimized” Medical Model. We are one of twelve centers in the country that has moved to this process. This model increases the effectiveness of our clinic in reaching our primary objective of enabling abortion-minded and abortion-vulnerable women in choosing to have their babies.

The Optimization Tool (OT) streamlines the way we reach and serve abortion-minded women. It provides a service process for intentionally moving a woman through a series of steps to help her have her baby and is focused on providing clearly defined, measurable results. Measurable results are important so that we can be effective and relevant to the women that need our services. They provide answers as to whether we are reaching our target group

(pregnant and abortion-minded). The other OT centers observed that the OT interaction with patients “reduced their confusion and increased their confidence which resulted in women being more open and receptive to our services as well as the gospel presentation.”

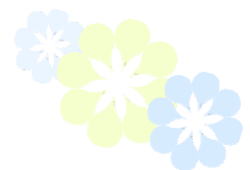
We are thankful for each life saved in these past 26 years of ministry, but God has called us to be more proactive and effective for His glory. We believe that no sane woman “wants” to have an abortion. Women have abortions because they feel insecure and unsupported. In fact, we saw two women this week that were being

pressured, one from a boyfriend and one from a parent, to have an abortion. But if a woman is afforded peace of mind and security, more often than not she will choose life for her baby. We have seen

20 women choose life for their babies so far this year. We are rejoicing that the Optimization Tool is working to reach the women who are calling us and making appointments.

And to think, all this is happening and we have yet to put all of our advertising campaign in place. Imagine how many more women we will see when this is done. I invite you again to be a part of this cutting edge ministry and its new direction. Now more than ever, we need your prayers and donations as we reach those who think abortion is the only answer. But, more importantly, we need your support for the sake of their unborn children who have a right to live.
