Dear Faithful Life Supporter,

The Women's First Choice Medical Center is an optimized center. An optimized approach is a problem-focused approach which we believe is a Biblical model for what we do. We are working to reverse the abortion trend in our country one step...one person at a time. We offer information and services to each patient to address the problems and crisis she is facing even when she sometimes is not even aware of her heart issues. We give her answers to questions she hasn't even thought about. Jesus did that for us. He showed us our need for Him even when we weren't aware of just how much we needed a Savior.

Our core values that are at the foundation of what we do are a fighting spirit (we keep doing what God has called us to do), relevance (we do the things He has called us to do), and accountability (we do those things in the right way). So when we hear that, nationally, all the Pregnancy Resource Centers are only reaching 1-3% of abortion-minded women, we keep working knowing there is much work yet to be done.

Compared to how many women Planned Parenthood and other abortion providers reach, you can see we have our work cut out for us. However, God encourages us with women like Abby Johnson. She is a former Planned Parenthood Director at a clinic in Texas. She not only left her job in 2009 after being confronted with the truth about abortion, but she has now started a ministry to other Planned Parenthood workers. She is speaking out about the deception of Planned Parenthood and is helping former workers to relocate and find other jobs. May God use her and others to bring down the "Goliath" of abortion providers in our country.

Here in our own backyard of Tifton and the surrounding counties, we don't have an abortion clinic but women are still driving almost 2 hours away to get their abortions. Dr. Martha Shuping, a psychiatrist who has counseled post-abortive women, says "having been entrusted with the intimate details of hundreds of abortions, I now could not truthfully say there are no risks: Women's hearts are at risk with abortion, and peer-reviewed research increasingly confirms the risks

to women's mental health." That is why it is so important that our clinic captures the attention of these women before they drive out of town. We, along with other centers across the nation, want to see more abortion-minded women come through our doors. We want the chance to share with them how abortion hurts them emotionally.

To do this, we are working on an ambitious marketing plan that will reach students through social media and on-campus advertising. Connecting with students is vital. They are among the most likely to consider abortion should an unplanned pregnancy arise, and they are also the most likely to respond to a powerful advertising campaign. Our goal is that during the 2012-2013 school year Women's First Choice Medical becomes the *first choice* for any of these students facing an unplanned pregnancy.

Georgia's Personhood Amendment

"Sixty-six percent of voters in July 31st's GOP primary expressed support for amending the Constitution of Georgia in the future to grant the "paramount right to life" to all human beings from their earliest biological existence until natural death."



"Personhood amendments do not grant rights to anyone—they merely recognize the God-given rights of every individual human being," said Georgia Right To Life President Dan Becker in a statement Wednesday. "The people of Georgia have shown that they are ready to vote 'Yes' on personhood. It is time for the legislature to ensure that the Georgia Personhood amendment is on the ballot ... time to let every Georgian decide the human rights issue of the 21st century."
